Victoria Campbell and Rosemary Clarke are your two Community Builders/Timebank Brokers for Brixham. We encourage people of all ages to get involved in their neighbourhood. With extensive local knowledge your Community Builder can connect you with like-minded people, groups or organisations in your community. We focus on what is strong not what is wrong. This way of working is known as Asset Based Community Development or ABCD for short. We have seen lives transformed when people of all ages work alongside their Community Builder to bring positive changes to the place they live. We have seen many new friendships and activities happening in the community, from coffee mornings to ballroom dancing, crafting workshops to mingle nights, and most importantly neighbours helping each other on a day to day basis.

Your Community Builders can also help you to join the Torbay Timebank where you can offer up your skills as well as requesting help from others, in exchange for credits rather than cash. The possibilities for the Timebank are endless – you might need a haircut, jobs doing in the garden, help with your shopping, your dog walking, or some small DIY tasks done around your home.
